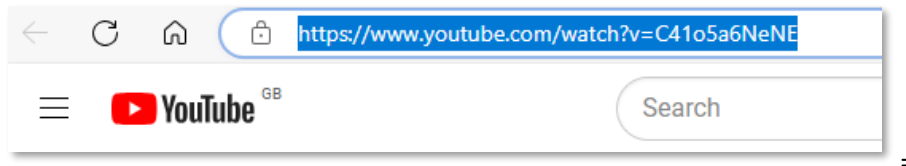


Adding Videos to a PowerPoint Presentation

There are two ways to include links to internet videos in a PowerPoint presentation;

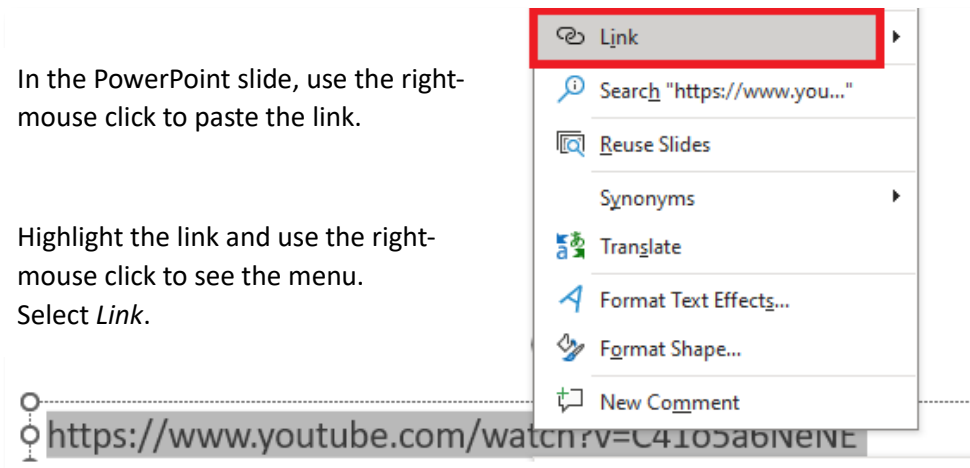
1. Add a link which opens in a browser (Chrome, Edge, Safari, etc) and plays out with the slideshow.
2. Embed the video link in a slide so that it plays within the slideshow

Firstly, use a browser to find the video and copy the link, eg. a YouTube link:

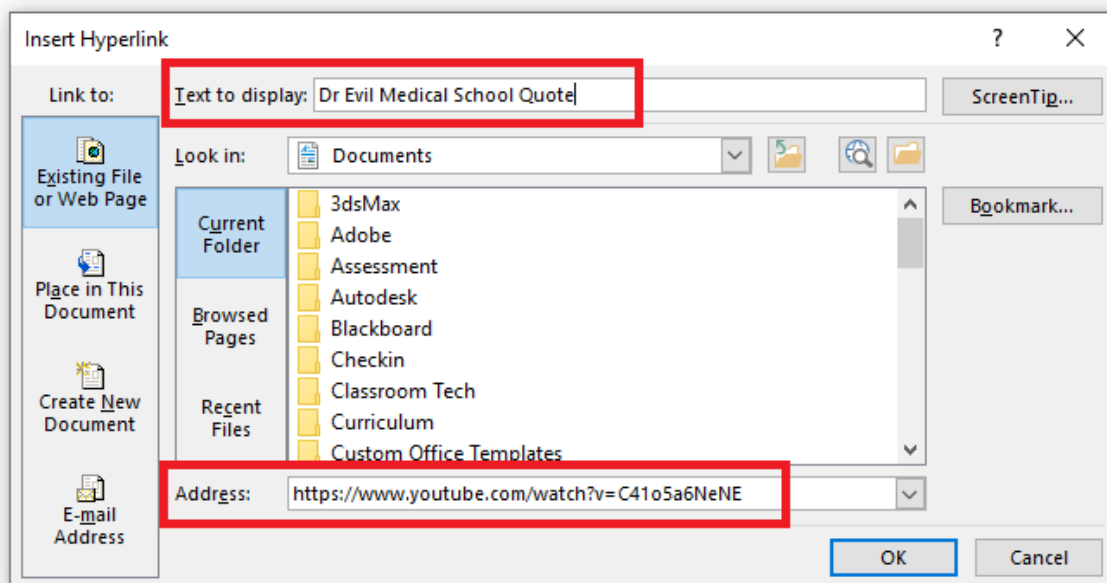


Add a video link

1. In the PowerPoint slide, use the right-mouse click to paste the link.
2. Highlight the link and use the right-mouse click to see the menu. Select *Link*.



3. Paste the link into the *Address* field. You may wish to change the *Text to display* to something more meaningful within the context of the PowerPoint slide.

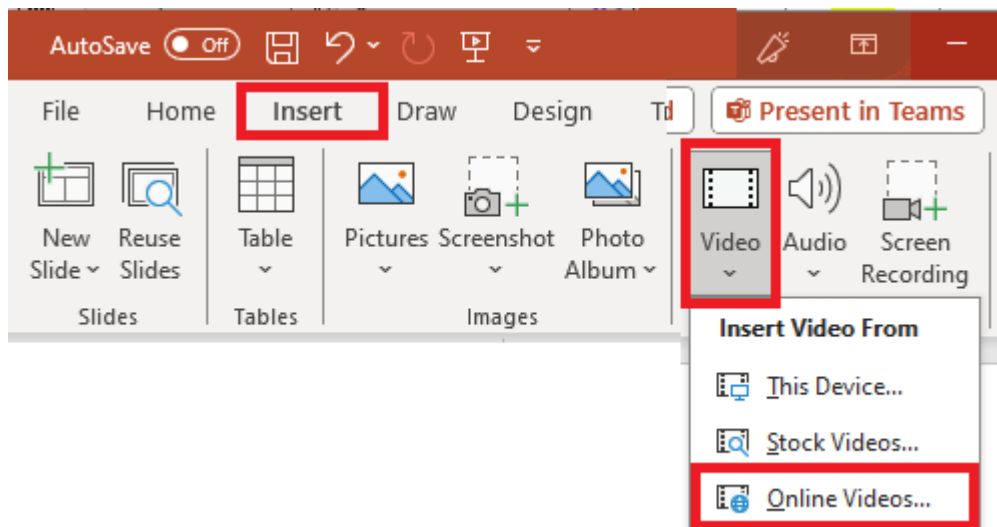


- Click OK and the text will now be an active link which opens in a browser (Chrome, Edge, Safari, etc) and plays out with the PowerPoint slideshow.

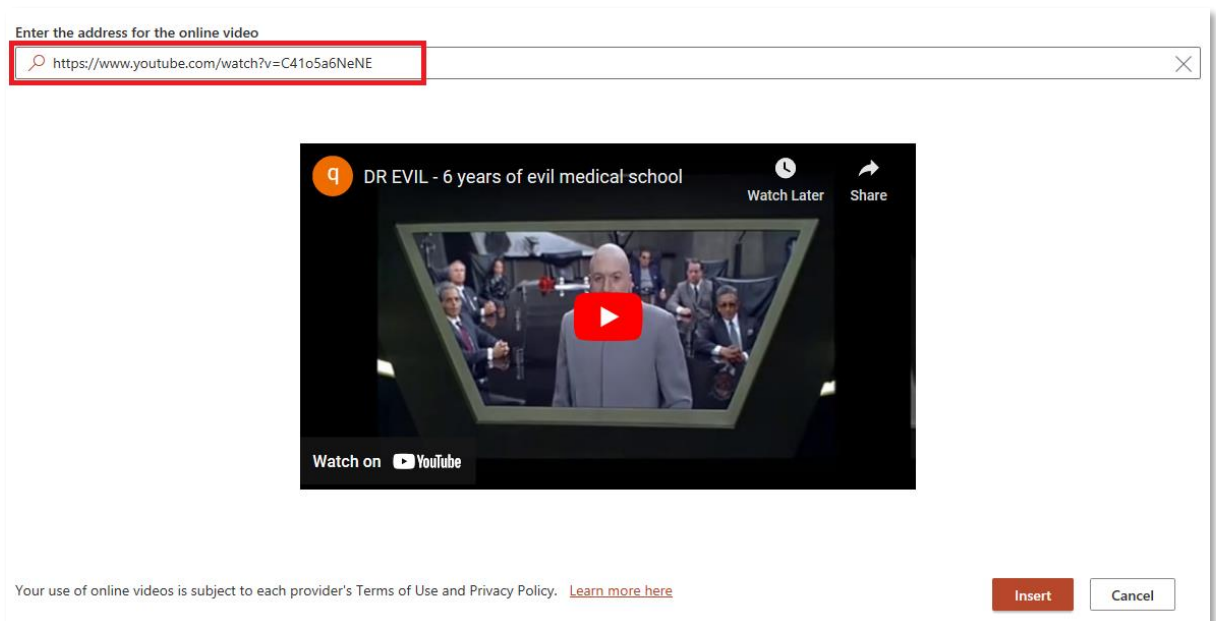

Embed a video link

- Click *Insert* and from the right hand side of the ribbon click *Video* and choose *Online Videos*.



- Paste the link which should generate a preview of the video. Then click *Insert*.



3. Use the edge points to resize the embed so that it fits appropriately within the slide.



4. When playing back the video enable the captions by clicking the CC icon.
