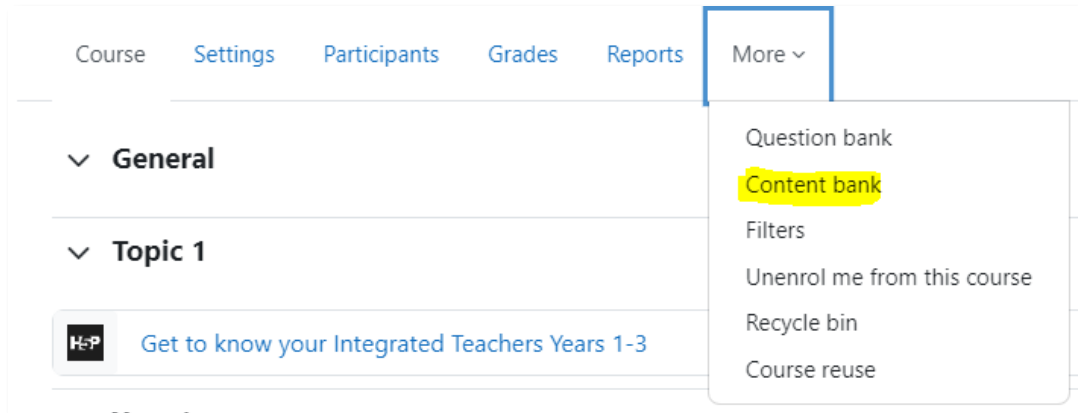
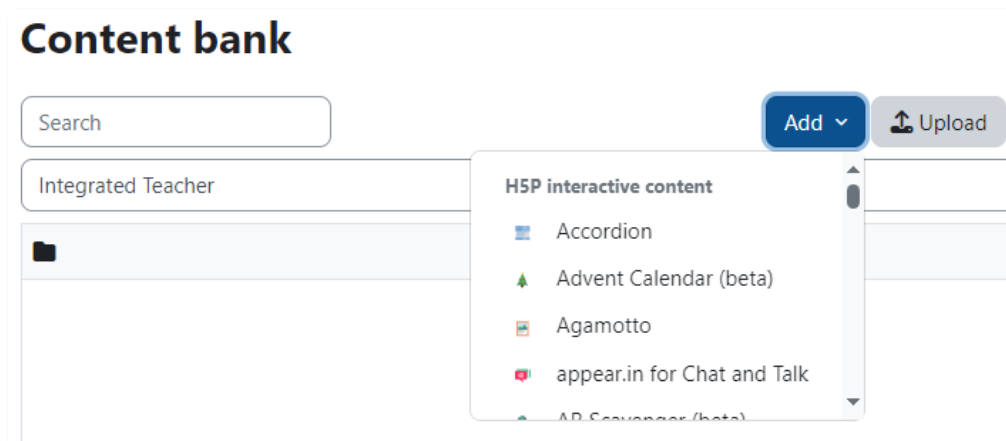


Adding H5P to Moodle




Create or upload an H5P content to your course *Content Bank*.....



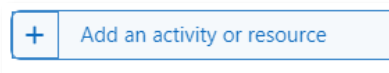

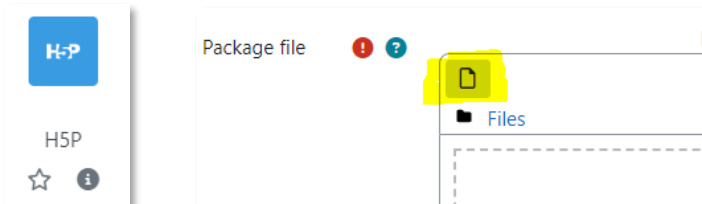

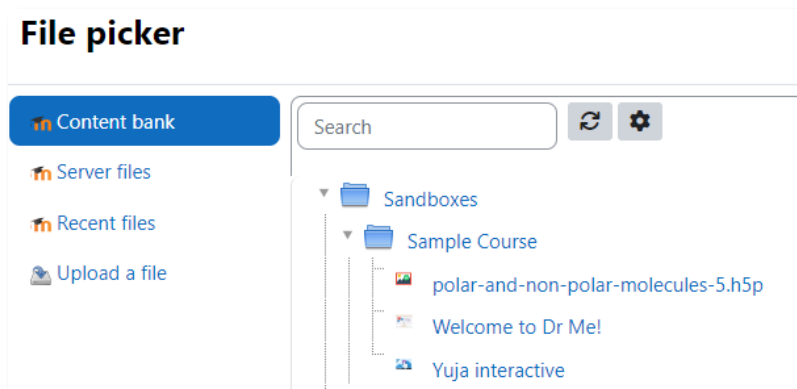
Option 1: From your course page turn editing on and click *Add an activity or resource*....



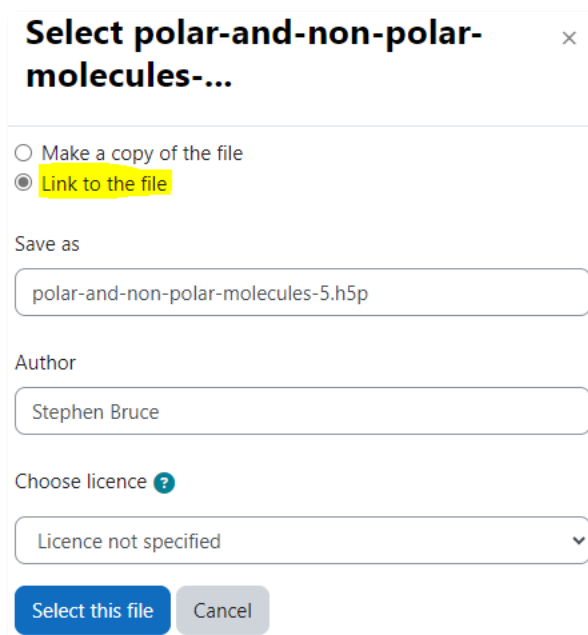
Select the blue H5P activity icon and then click the *Package file* icon




From the *File picker* select *Content bank* and scroll down the folders until you see your course, and then click the H5P content....



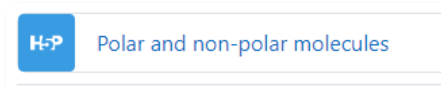
Select to *Link to the file* and then *Select this file*....



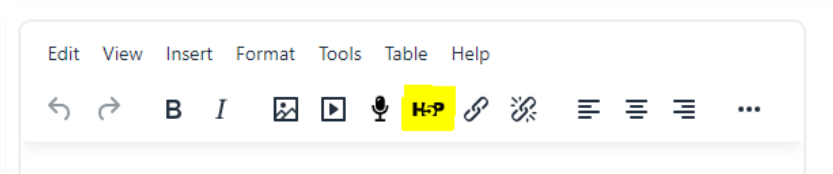
Add a name and then click *Save and display* or *Save and return to course*.




The H5P content is now available to students...



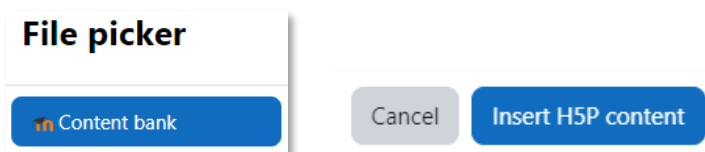
Option 2: Embed an H5P content within a Moodle Page or anywhere the editor appears....
